- Committee is made up of one representatives from BCET, CCBC, CTC, and BVIU

 3. What do you feel is the most important problem that society is facing, and why?

Personal Writing Narrative

The following are requirements for the Personal Writing Narrative:

- Submit 100 to 300 words about yourself and your goals.
- Type your narrative and attach it to the application.
- Be sure to include experiences, activities and accomplishments you feel are pertinent.

Additional Required Information

- You must attach a copy of your high school transcript with your name blacked out.
- Attach any letters of acceptance you have received from Colleges / Universities referenced above with your name blacked out.
